REGISTRATION

Parents/guardians will need to complete a registration/medical form and return to IDA. At IDA we use **SPOND** to communicate with all parents/guardians, as well as collecting payments. Parents/guardians are required to download the app and create a free account using the email provided on the IDA registration form.

PAYMENTS

Fees are charged per month at £10 per session, these will vary depending on the number of sessions in a month. The monthly fees must be paid prior to commencement date via the SPOND app. Please note that fees are non-refundable. For any payment concerns, please contact us directly.



KIT

At Academy level, it is compulsory for our members to attend training sessions wearing the IDA training kit and black football boots are advised



PLAYER RULES

Before training:

- Wear the correct training kit
- Arrive on time at least 5 minutes before the session starts
- Clean your football boots/astros and GK gloves
- Training shirt tucked in and socks pulled up
- You must bring a drink (water)

At training:

- Join in the arrival activity (rondos/football tennis etc.)
- Do not kick footballs around or into the goals unless asked to by a coach
- · Listen and pay attention when the coach is talking

After training:

- You must help pack away all the equipment
- Don't forget your belongings
- Put rubbish in the bin
- Shake hands with your coach at the end

Please note:

Failure to follow the rules will result in being asked to leave the training session.

PARENT RULES

At training:

- To stand in the designated area when watching
- To follow the venues rules (e.g. no smoking etc.)
- No shouting or coaching from the side
- If you have questions, please ask the coaches at the end of the session, or contact them via SPOND.

Payments:

- Payments must be made via SPOND
- Training fees are to be paid regardless of attendance
- A minimum of 2 week's notice must be given if membership is cancelled. Failure to notify IDA will result in payment still being charged.
- If there are any issues with payments, please inform IDA immediately
- Failure to make payments will lead to your child being asked to leave IDA

Please note:

If any of these rules and expectations are not followed by the parents/spectators, your child will risk losing their place in ID Academy.





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
